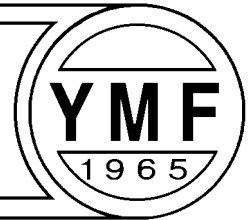

This year's tournament will be held **Monday September 11, 2006 at the Rancho Murieta Country Club**. The half-day event includes lunch, a scramble format tournament on the beautiful North Course, and dinner. It's a great opportunity to golf, meet others in the engineering and construction community, and support the local chapter of Make-A-Wish Foundation.

As in previous years, the net proceeds will go to support the local chapter of Make-A-Wish ([www.makeawish-sacto.org](http://www.makeawish-sacto.org)). Last year's tournament was yet another great success! Through generous donations from our sponsors and players we were able to raise over \$10,000 to grant wishes for local children between the ages of 2 ½ and 18 with life threatening medical conditions. Our goal is to raise at least \$10,000 again this year.

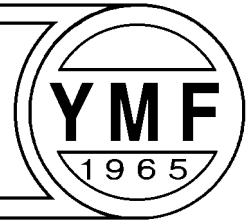
