



**Subject: 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Sacramento ASCE Charity Golf Tournament**

It is with great pleasure that we invite you, your co-workers, and your guests to the tenth annual ASCE Charity Golf Tournament. This year's tournament will be held **Monday, July 28, 2008, at Rancho Murieta Country Club**. This half-day event includes lunch, a scramble format tournament on the beautiful North Course, and dinner. It's a great opportunity to golf, meet others in the engineering and construction community, and support the local chapter of the Make-A-Wish Foundation.

As in previous years, the net proceeds will go to support the local chapter of Make-A-Wish ([www.makeawish-sacto.org](http://www.makeawish-sacto.org)). Make-A-Wish used this money to grant wishes for local children between the ages of 2 ½ and 18 with life threatening medical conditions. This year our goal is to again raise over \$15,000.
