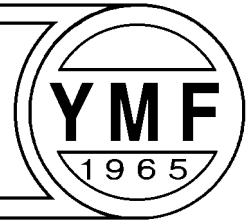
**Newsletter**

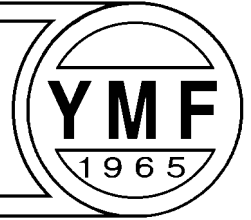
We got started on the design of our new website and we have a site navigation map and a draft layout.
