Cars and cow hides and dinosaur bones? Who knew these were the types of things found buried deep "inside" the city of Stockton! On Thursday, May 6, 2010 Ron Heinzen of Kleinfelder gave the group a presentation on "The Challenges of Building in Downtown Stockton". Ron is a registered GE at Kleinfelder, Inc. in Stockton, CA. He was named Engineer of the Year in 2008 by the San Joaquin Engineer's Council and has worked in Stockton for much of his 36 year career. Ron is a wealth of information and history of Stockton's old sloughs and river channels, and of what's become of these areas. When new developers try to build on old land, or try to renovate old buildings, Ron is there to see what the land has in store for them and to help come up with creative solutions to the challenges posed by soft soils deposits and other "fill" materials below.
